- 3. COVID-19 impacted us different ways. In 200 words or less, explain the skills, gifts and tools you used to continue to inspire hope in your homes, parish, schools and or communities in the face of adversity. List any projects or extracurricular activities you participated in.
- 4. If you receive funds from the Saint James Scholarship, how do you intend to use those funds?(100 words or less)

You will receive confirmation of receipt of your application to your email address within two business days of receipt.
